Mr Chan was appointed the General Manager of ST Electronics (Training & Simulation Systems) Pte Ltd on 1 January 2014, having served as its Deputy General Manager from 1 July 2013.

Graduating from the Nanyang Technological Institute, on a Singapore Aircraft Industries Scholarship, with a Bachelor of Engineering (Electrical & Electronics) in 1985, Mr Chan went on to obtain a Master of Science (Electrical Engineering) from the National University of Singapore (NUS) in 1990. He also attended the General Management Programme at the NUS Business School in 1995 and the International Executive Program at INSEAD (Fontainebleau, France) in 2007.

He began his career as a Project Engineer in the Industrial Systems Division of Singapore Electronics & Engineering Limited in 1985, specialising in security and CCTV systems. Having worked as a Calibration Engineer, Mr Chan then went on to hold various department head appointments before helping the Test & Measurement Division as its Manager, overseeing the business of the Instrument Calibration Centre, Electromagnetic Compatibility Centre, Automatic Test Equipment Centre and Antenna Engineering Centre.

Appointed Division Manager, Maintenance and Customer Services of ST Electronics' Large-Scale Systems Group (LSG) in 1998, he was responsible for the company's maintenance business in defence, transportation, intelligent building, and airport systems and was later appointed Vice President, Marketing. During his tenure, he successfully led and achieved major inroads into the Civil Aviation market, capturing a multi-million, multi-year project and maintenance business for its Air Traffic Management (ATM). He was also instrumental in growing LSG's systems integration business for naval and air defence systems, and the development of ST Electronics' Unmanned Surface Vessels. He last held the appointment of Senior Vice President, Defence Business Unit in LSG.
