



**Mr LAU Thiam Beng**  
**Deputy President (Operations) & President, Defence Business**

Mr Lau Thiam Beng took on the responsibility as Deputy President (Operations) of ST Electronics on 1 January 2011. He is concurrently President, Defence Business of ST Electronics, a position he has held since 17 August 2009.

Mr Lau first joined ST Electronics (Info-Comm Systems), then known as CET Technologies Pte Ltd, in July 2000 as the Director of Wireless Broadband. He was appointed the company's General Manager in January 2002 and subsequently its President in December 2004.

He grew the business over the years, drawing on his depth of experience during his six years with the Institute of Communications Research (formerly known as Centre for Wireless Communications of the National University of Singapore) from 1994. Mr Lau has held several senior appointments including Division Manager of the Cellular Systems Division with the last held position being Director of Operations and Business Development. Mr Lau also served in AT&T Bell Laboratories (Singapore and US) from 1987 to 1994 as a Research & Development Manager involved in the development of wireless products for the international market.

Mr Lau is the Chairman of STELCOMMS Pte Ltd and Telematics Wireless Ltd, and sits on the Boards of ST Electronics (Info-Comm Systems) Pte Ltd, ST Electronics (Info-Security) Pte Ltd, ST Electronics (Info-Software) Pte Ltd, ST Electronics (Training & Simulation Systems) Pte Ltd, STELOP Pte Ltd and SAF Care Fund. He is also a member of the Institute for Infocomm Research (I<sup>2</sup>R) Alumni Executive Committee, IES Systems Engineering Technical Committee, and the Steering Committee to the Saudi-Singapore Business Council (SSBC).

Graduating with a First Class Honours degree in Electronics Engineering from the National University of Singapore in 1987, Mr Lau went on to obtain a Master of Business Administration from the State University of New York, Buffalo, USA in 2002. In 2005, he attended the Executive Management Program at the Harvard Business School. He has also been awarded the Certified Systems Engineering Professional (CSEP) Certificate by The Institution of Engineers Singapore in September 2008.
